



BEACHES

August is a convenient time to have fun studying the representation of beaches since the invention of photography.

Can we say that beaches were invented at the same time as photography?

In fact, beaches were rarely visited before the mid-19th century, and sea bathing only became a popular and democratic practice in the inter-war years: in the 1920s and 1930s, access to beaches was promoted by governments with diametrically opposed ideas, but who were engaged in an international competition in the physical health of young generations.

But antiquated beaches awaiting the arrival of future tourists allow us to invoke the glorious literary past of the first travelers.

Albumen print number 1, for example, allows us to sketch the plump figure of Alexandre Dumas, whom our imagination places that morning on the beach at Chiaia in Naples: The author of Monte Cristo could well be there, following Garibaldi's invitation to enjoy one of the most beautiful palaces in the Partenopean city by appointing him director of the new newspaper ...

Possiamo dire che le spiagge sono state inventate contemporaneamente alla fotografia?

Le spiagge erano raramente frequentate prima della metà del XIX secolo e i bagni di mare sono diventati una pratica popolare e democratica solo tra le due guerre: negli anni Venti e Trenta, l'accesso alle spiagge è stato promosso da governi con idee diametralmente opposte, ma impegnati in una competizione internazionale per la salute fisica delle giovani generazioni.

Ma le spiagge antiquate che attendono l'arrivo dei futuri turisti ci permettono di invocare il glorioso passato letterario dei primi viaggiatori.

La stampa all'albumina numero 1, ad esempio, ci permette di tratteggiare la figura paffuta di Alexandre Dumas, che la nostra immaginazione colloca quella mattina sulla spiaggia della Chiaia a Napoli: L'autore di Montecristo potrebbe essere lì, a seguito dell'invito di Garibaldi a godersi uno dei più bei palazzi della città partenopea, nominandolo direttore del nuovo giornale...

Spiaggia di Chiaia al tempo di Alexandre Dumas Napoli, ca. 1860

Early albumen print, 255x315 mm, on mount

Via Caracciolo was built ten yearts later, provided with a small marina for sailors to compensate for the loss of the beach. Behind the photographer, and slightly set back from the present street front, was the Albergo delle Crocelle, where the city's most eminent guests, including Giacomo Casanova, stayed. Opposite the hotel, by the sea, was a place of delight, which belonged to Prince Michele Imperiali. With Giuseppe Garibaldi's entry into Naples, the building became the editorial office of the newspaper L'Indipendente founded and directed by Alexandre Dumas, who lived at the casino for seven years.




2. Travel photographer (Glossy albumen artist) Santa Lucia before the Sea-Fill Napoli, ca. 1860

In 1869 work began on the sea-fill by which the land was extended from Via Santa Lucia to the vicinity of the Castel dell'Ovo. This quite unusual glossy albumen print treatment may allow an identification of the operator.



Domenico Anderson continued his father's business in 1877 and eventually established his own studio at 7 Salaria Street. It may have been an opportunity for the photographer to take a self-portrait as an amateur fisherman, it also explains why the beach is so depicted, it allows the boat to stand in the middle. It's fascinating to think that the Castel Sant'Angelo, marking the beginning of the fields, was the last building in the city of Rome in mid 19th century

The seaside resort of Do Son located 22 kms from the port of Haiphong, west of Cat Ba Island and Halong Bay, was created at the end of the 19th century as a rest base for French servicemen on leave, and as a resort for French civilians

Philippe, Duc d'Orléans (1869-1926) is best remembered for having returned to France in 1890 to do his military service, thus defying the exile laws. He was arrested, sentenced to two years' imprisonment and finally expelled. The pretender to the French throne lived most of his life in England.

An avid traveler - India, Ethiopia, the Arctic - hunter, ornithologist and taxidermist, Philippe, Duc d'Orléans left behind several hundred photographs taken during his many stays in various European countries. (cf. Photographies de Philippe, duc d'Orléans, Nov. 2001 - Feb. 2002, Musée d'Orsay)


Lebnert returned to Tunis in 1930 to resume his work as a portrait painter. He opened a studio in the newly-built Colisée complex on avenue Jules Ferry, and moved into a house he had built in Sainte-Monique, facing the hill of Sidi Bou Saïd

Hôtel des Herbages was the first hotel, built in 1852 by a certain Lepareur, a Paris merchant, and really launched the resort. Villa Durenne was built two years later, commissioned by Pitre-Chevalier, then editor-in-chief of Le Figaro. Then, in 1855, Félix Pigeory, seduced by the site, bought 100,000 m2 of land for the construction of sumptuous villas, built the casino and the bathing establishment on the seafront, and drew up the plan for the future seaside resort

Berck took on a therapeutic vocation under the Second Empire. It all began with the initiative of a sailor's widow: Marie Anne Brillard, known as Marianne-toute-seule, had the idea of giving sea baths to the sick children entrusted to her care. The local doctor noted the improvement in their health and reported on the incredible density of iodine concentrated in Berck. Today, Marianne-toute-seule is considered the inventor of thalassotherapy.

It's hard to consider a professional beach photographer, because we're in a short, calm interval in the middle of a particularly turbulent period. Prince Lvov's resignation allowed Kerensky to head a transitional cabinet from July 21, 1917. At the end of July, with the approval of the soviet, he formed a new government with a socialist majority. Kerensky, for the first time master of the country, would remain at Russia's helm for almost 100 days. At the age of 35, he was on all fronts, all stages, all platforms, leading both the elimination of members of the old regime and their defense when the mob threatened their lives. At this moment, the head of government's popularity is extreme






















