
The origin of Fellig's pseudonym is uncertain. One of his earliest jobs was in the photo lab of The New York Times, where (in a reference to the tool used to wipe down prints) he was nicknamed "squeegee boy". Later, during his employment with Acme Newspictures, his skill and ingenuity in developing prints on the run (e.g., in a subway car) earned him the name "Mr. Squeegee".[11] He may subsequently have been dubbed "Weegee"—a phonetic rendering of Ouija—because his instant and seemingly prescient arrivals at scenes of crimes or other emergencies seemed as magical as a Ouija board.



Weegee (Arthur *Ascher* Fellig, 1899-1968) Fritz Kuhn, the "American Führer", charged for larceny and forgery, NYC, 26 May 1939

On 20 February 1939, Kuhn held the largest and most publicized rally in the *German American Bund*'s history at Madison Square Garden in New York City. Some 22,000 people attended and heard Kuhn mock President Franklin D. Roosevelt as "Frank D. Rosenfeld", calling his New Deal the "Jew Deal" and denouncing what he called Bolshevik-Jewish American leadership. Later in 1939, seeking to cripple the Bund, New York City Mayor Fiorello La Guardia ordered the city to investigate the Bund's taxes. It alleged that Kuhn had embezzled \$14,548 from the organization, spending part of the money on a mistress.












































NASA - Orbiter III Lunar Surface from a Distance, 1967










